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Uniform Reminders

We ask all parents who send their children to our school to support the school uniform policy, so children arrive at school correctly dressed and ready for their daily schoolwork. One of the responsibilities of parents is to ensure that their child has the correct uniform, and that it is clean and in good repair.

The uniform is as follows:

- Navy sweatshirt or navy cardigan (with or without the school logo)
- White shirt / blouse with a collar
- Grey trousers or shorts
- Grey skirt or pinafore (in summer, a blue and white summer dress may be worn)
- Black, sensible shoes (not trainers)
- Grey, black or white socks
- Grey, black or navy tights
- School tie

Leggings and trainers are not permitted in day-to-day uniform. All items of clothing and footwear must be labelled with the pupil's name. We strongly discourage the wearing of expensive fashion coats or jackets since we cannot take responsibility for loss or damage of items of clothing.

Thank you for supporting us with the correct school uniform. The children do look so smart wearing it and have a sense of belonging to our school.
